New Business

- Home Hardware has a limited supply of rope lighting. What they have is \$15.00 per 15foot strand. They have offered a deal to the LUD of Warren Committee if they pre-order for delivery in the fall. There are no lawn-style ornaments left in stock.
- > D. Friesen proposed an idea for the Christmas display of an old vehicle.
- C. Olson priced out the rubber mats for the outdoor arena. 3/16" thick and 4' x 8' are approximately \$65.00/mat and the supplier has a lot on hand.
- It was decided to go ahead with the purchase of a Concrete Picnic Table for the Hanway Park in 2021.
- There are currently 2 concrete bins at the Public Works Shop in Warren. L. Brown to discuss with the Operations Manager as to their purpose and possibly changing the lids to be used for garbage in the LUD of Warren.
- A sign for Hanway Park was discussed. The committee will look into the cost of a steel cut sign from Rocklake Colony.
- The committee would like to look into a promotional sign for the end of Ed Peltz Way coming into Warren.
- Solar lights were priced out for Hanway Park in Warren. They are cost prohibitive at this time. The committee will investigate having an arm installed on the hydro pole close to the property.
- Garbage and recycling pick up in Warren. Going forward, garbage and recycling pickup will be weekly, all year.
