Budget

The Committee reviewed the response from the Public Works Foreperson regarding items requested at the previous meeting.

The Committee also discussed and added capital items to the 2026 budget, including plans to move forward with the paving of Hanlan. Other larger capital items discussed included playground equipment at Lions Park and contribution to the Invicta Trail project.

A dip on MacDonald was noted that requires attention. The Committee discussed the possibility of addressing this issue while the contractor is completing the Hanlan paving in order to reduce costs.

Outstanding projects from the prior year that have not yet been completed will be carried forward into the 2026 budget. These include the dog park shelter and repairs to the red barn and water tower in Lions Park.

The Committee discussed line painting priorities, and Cal will prepare a list of priority areas for review. The timing of line painting and street sweeping was also discussed. It was noted that it may be necessary to bring the street sweeper back to complete sweeping prior to line painting, or alternatively delay line painting until after the paving of Hanlan has been completed.

It was noted that Green Lawn provides Christmas light installation services. The Committee discussed the possibility of installing Christmas lights at Lions Park instead of the Multipurpose

Building. While the park currently has power available, it may be necessary to install either overhead or underground electrical connections to reach the trees.
